



## **Kenbrook Krew Camper Job Description Revised 12/09**

**Responsible To:** Krew Directors and in-charge area supervisors (Head Cook and Maintenance Director)

**Purpose:** The purpose of Kenbrook Bible Camp is to make and develop disciples of Jesus Christ and to facilitate healing and growth in each person's relationship with God, others, one's self, and the created world. In keeping with this purpose, Kenbrook Krew is the summer service program of the camp. Central to this purpose is the development of servant leaders as molded by Jesus Christ. We believe that the Kenbrook Krew is a great opportunity for you to be part of the "support team" at Kenbrook Bible Camp and to give of yourself in service to the Lord.

Participating in the Krew program is far more than just another week at camp. It' is a ministry and an opportunity to be stretched and challenged in your personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Krew members assist the Kenbrook staff, working as a team, to glorify God by serving the body of Christ and our community through relationships, programs, and services that promote evangelism and discipleship. Consequently it is vital that our Krew understand that "going the extra mile"—serving beyond the scope of our job description—is often a part of what we are called to do. Whatever our task, we must bear in mind that our service is ultimately unto the Lord. It is for His glory and honor that we serve.

### **Qualifications:**

- Be 14-16 years of age
- Desire to learn what it takes to be a servant leader
- Ability to relate to one's peer Group
- Enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience, and self-control
- Evidence of a personal relationship with Christ
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance
- Have the desire and maturity to minister consistently with the philosophy and goals of Kenbrook Bible Camp

### **Responsibilities:**

- Serve in assignment that may be in the area of kitchen or maintenance
- Actively participate in a discipleship program led by the Krew Director
- Assist with the evening all-camp recreation activities as coordinated and led by the Program Director
- Abide by the guidelines, policies and procedures of camp.
- Maintain your personal daily quiet time throughout the summer
- Be loyal, supportive and edifying to your fellow ministry team members—communicate needs or problems directly to the Krew Director to avoid slandering one another
